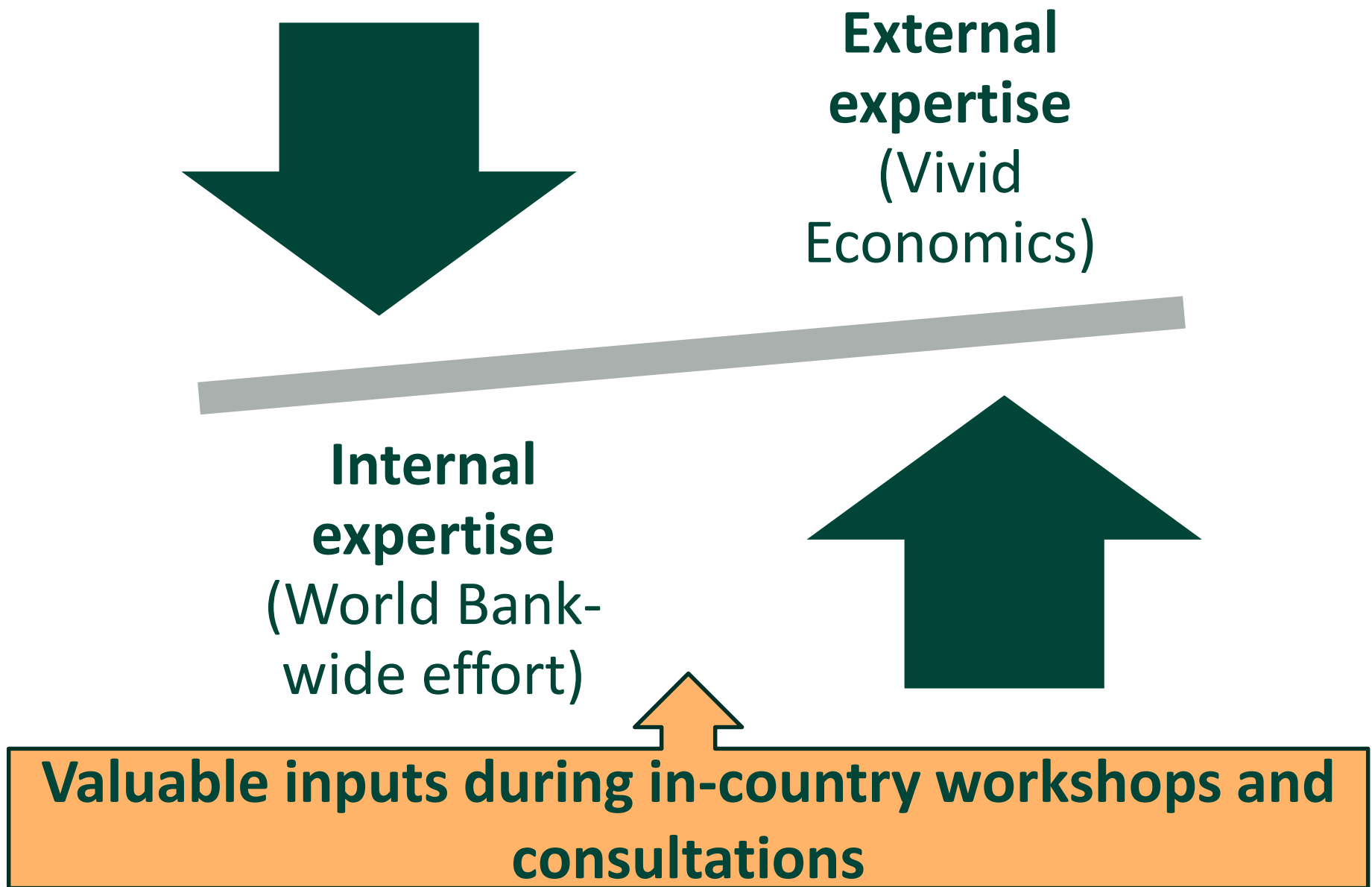

1. contribute to establish **post-2020 mitigation scenarios** and package of effective and cost-efficient **policies**
2. **provide useful inputs** to countries devising, presenting and implementing their nationally determined contributions
 - both today and over the longer term as set out in the Paris Agreement

'Checklist' Development: Consultative and Participatory Process



The 'checklist' consists of four components

1 Country context

2 Baseline pathways

3 Alternative emissions scenarios

4 Results presentation

Provide context for emissions analysis



context of

- sectoral emissions and socio-economic significance
- emissions drivers

how

- existing national and international sources
- descriptive statistics and accompanying narrative
- data quality assessment

Generate baseline pathways



1. trend extrapolation
2. augmented trend extrapolation
3. decomposition projection
4. detailed bottom up analysis

approaches vary by sophistication/accuracy but also by costs and resources

transparency, accounting for uncertainty can make it more robust

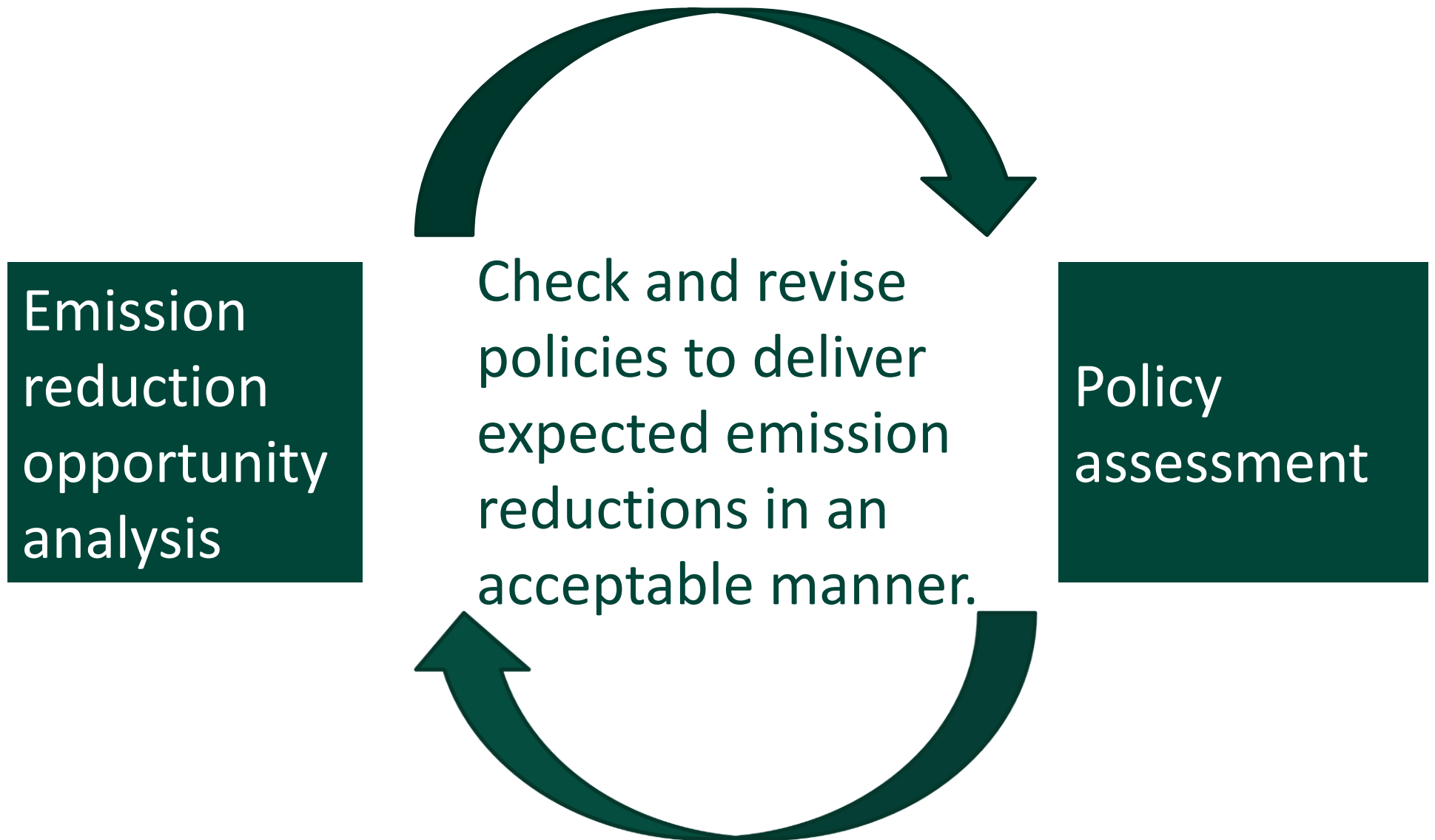
Create alternative emissions pathways



1. technical analysis of emission reduction opportunities
2. analysis of policy options
3. combination and iteration the two

regardless of approach, range of different pathways can be beneficial

Deriving alternative pathways through technical and policy analysis is the most robust

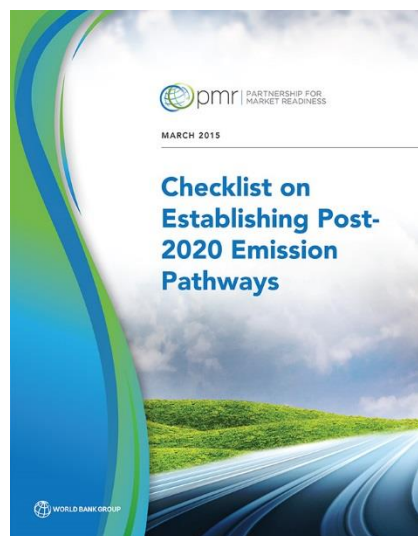
